2019 – THE FIRST STEP


Our journey began on January 23, 2019, with a heartfelt visit and donations to an orphanage in Ibadan, Nigeria, home to infants aged 0-18 months. Later that year, our volunteers visited another home caring for orphans with special needs, sharing love, essentials, and hope. These small beginnings laid the foundation for a global mission.

2020 - EXPANDING TO UGANDA



In 2020, we began supporting over 200 children in Uganda—including orphans, abandoned children, and those raised by mentally unstable or impoverished parents.


